

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Garage Sale

Garage sales are fun and easy with something for everyone! Bring together your neighbours, friends, colleagues or family to sell items you no longer use.

In-Person Option

People can contact you beforehand and inform you of what items they wish to contribute. On the day of, the donated items are displayed and sold, with all the proceeds going to Blue Door.

Virtual Option

Using a platform or program, such as VarageSale, your group can easily create an account, post the donated items, and arrange for them to be picked up.



A fun interactive way to showcase your talents!

In-Person Option

Costs and effort for setting up this event can vary depending on your facilities, though most schools and churches already have a stage and sound system in place. Organize the performers, get the word out, charge admission and/or sell items like snacks and beverages throughout the event to raise funds!



Virtual Option

Have interested performers send in video submissions of their performance. Using platforms such as YouTube Live or Zoom, everyone can still gather, and watch people share their talents! Set a minimum donation price to attend.







FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Trivia Night

Trivia; there's nothing quite like it. Fun, friendly competition, and learning, all for a good cause!

Onsite Option

This is a great way to learn more about Blue Door and homelessness, all while having fun as a community! To raise money, you can charge admission or charge to play.

Virtual Option

Similar to the virtual talent show, use YouTube Live or Zoom to hold and host the trivia night. People can pay a minimum donation/fee to play and receive the meeting link and information.









Video Game Tournament

Here is a fun one for all the kids or kids at heart! Some fun and friendly competition, all for a good cause!

Onsite Option

Set up the game and necessary equipment, have people register and enter the tournament by donating a minimum amount, and watch the fun unfold!

Virtual Option

Create an event registration page, where participants can register themselves and make their donations. Arrange a time and date for the tournament to take place and, using platforms such as Twitch, all that is left to do is start your engines!

Bake Sale

Bake your favourite treats and charge a flat rate for each baked good someone buys, or make it interesting by having participants compete to bake the tastiest treat and have everyone vote for their favourite!

A cooking class is a great way to interact with your community in a relaxed, creative environment. Ask your employees or friends if anyone would be interested in leading the class, or turn to the experts and hire a chef to take the lead. Charge a flat registration fee or offer a fundraising minimum for supporters to earn their spot in class.





Walking Challenge

Start a virtual fitness challenge! Invite your friends, coworkers, and neighbours to compete in a daily step challenge. Charge a participation fee as a donation to get involved!

Bowling Tournament

Like all other tournaments, ask each team to fundraise a minimum amount for entry. You could also recruit partners to sponsor lanes or uniforms where they can feature their logos.





Craft Sale

If Pinterest has taught us anything, it's that the do-it-yourself aesthetic isn't going anywhere. Gather talented friends and family members to help create and sell custom crafts, like bracelets, paintings, keychains, or hand-stitched blankets.

Comedy Night

Laughter is one of the most powerful sources of connection. Recruit community members, local performers, and up-and-coming comics to show off their talents at your comedy night event.

Sell entry tickets and encourage participants/spectators to show additional support through the form of food and beverage purchases for suggested donation amounts.
